Among the invited were: adult training organizations, associations of elderly people, representatives of residences, and public bodies related to social affairs and services for the elderly, Some elder learners were invited to participate in the multiplier events so that they could learn the intellectual products developed. selected 10 stakeholders who participated in the different activities. Different experts in these fields helped to achieve the project's objectives with their knowledge











How satisfied were you with the event?

75 responses





















Takeaways from the event























How satisfied were you with the logistics?




Which sessions did you find most relevant?

Conclusion:

The workshop / Round table discussion encouraged participation and active learning. The moderator Luis Ochoa encouraged feedback between the speakers and participants. Participants contributed ideas and solutions to the different practical activities that were implemented. Teamwork was encouraged at all times and the active participation of all attendees, so that it served as a form of knowledge about the intellectual products of the ELENE project and for the exchange of opinions. Attendees receive pen drives and QR codes with all necessary material for a better understanding of the products presented and the objectives of the activity.



A suitable place was set up for the event, which had the necessary technical means for its development (WIFI, computer, projector, screen). INBIE were in charge of implementing social inclusion measures, such as facilitating accessibility for people with physical disabilities, ensuring gender equity, using non-violent communication and inclusive language and so on.

Regarding sustainability measures, to reduce the impact on the environment, the participants received a USB with the materials of the project (R1 & R2) as well as an eco-friendly cardboard pen and notebook and recycled paper to take notes.



















INBIE was responsible for carrying out the adequate dissemination of the activity carried out, both through the use of social networks and other channels of communication. Once the event was over, each attendee was awarded the corresponding accreditation that served as proof of attendance. All attendees filled out the attendance sheet.
